

The Audit Branch of Natural Resources Canada is looking for an experienced Information Systems Auditor with completed CISA designation for a one-year assignment opportunity in the IT/IM Audit Group in a supervisory role.

The IT/IM audit unit provides a focal point for risk analysis on departmental information technology policies, procedures, guidelines, programs and applications. The scope of audit coverage includes informatics activities at HQ and across Canada. The unit's resources also provide input, as the NRCan representative on interdepartmental committees and Central Agency initiatives related to government wide informatics-based audit/review activities, security considerations and shared systems initiatives. The focus of information systems audit unit activities is on the management of IT initiatives within NRCan ensure that IT/IM investments are strategically aligned with business directions and priorities. For new systems development initiatives the unit conducts Systems Under Development Audits (SUD). From a corporate perspective the major administrative systems are SAP and PeopleSoft.

This position would be of interest to anyone interested in working in a supervisory role and wanting experience that would enable career development to a more senior position upon the successful completion of the assignment. Reimbursement of Professional fees and CPE training are included as part of the assignment.

This position requires previous experience of no less than three years in the conduct of IT audits/consulting and professional certification as a Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA). Some prior experience with TeamMate would be beneficial, but is not mandatory.

Security Clearance: Security clearance at the level of Secret is a mandatory requirement of the position.

Note: Because of the short duration of this assignment, NRCan will not provide reimbursement for relocation expenses.

This position will be filled through the use of a secondment agreement between departments/agencies for persons already employed in the federal public sector.
