For immediate release.

On 15 May, two exposure drafts were posted on the ISACA web site for general comment.

The Standards Board is mandated to review and update guidance every three to five years. The IT Audit and Assurance Guideline G15 Planning has been updated in track changes and posted for a 30 day exposure period. Please submit your comments before the 15 June 2009 deadline.

A new guideline is also being exposed, Continuous Assurance is posted for a 60 day exposure period. Please submit your comments before the 15 July 2009 deadline.

The exposure drafts and online questionnaires are posted at www.isaca.org/standardexposure. All comments received will be carefully considered by the Standards Board.

Your input to the guidance for the profession is very important and it is hoped that you will review the drafts and provide any comments related to the documents to facilitate the exposure process. You are requested to complete the accompanying questionnaires posted along with the exposure documents. Please submit your comments online at www.isaca.org/standardexposure or e-mail standards@isaca.org.

CPE credits can be earned for exposure draft review but, because the time spent varies by individual, a CPE award form is not sent to reviewers. A form to report CPE hours is provided with the invoice for membership renewal and you may include the total hours spent reviewing standards exposure drafts for the year (limit 10 hours annually) in the category "Contributions to the IS audit and control profession." Note that an audit of CPE hours requires documentation for the hours, so print the online questionnaire with your feedback before submitting it or create a page with your notes to substantiate the CPE hours claimed for standards exposure draft review.
